Search for a Recorder and Treasurer

Dear Nobles:

Greetings! We hope you are having a wonderful summer and are enjoying your time outdoors, hopefully spending time with close family and friends.

As you may recall from the announcement made at the May Ceremonial, our Temple Recorder, Ricky Leftwich, and Treasurer, Jim Saul, have indicated they will not be serving in these compacities after this year. Accordingly, we will have to replace each of them for the 2023 year and beyond.

In an effort to keep the Nobility involved in major decisions at the Temple, we are requesting suggestions for individuals who might be capable in serving in these roles. We are hoping that by notifying all of you, ideas for individuals to serve in these capacities might be forthcoming.

The Treasurer is the Chief Financial Officer of the Temple. In recent years Jim Saul has been able to complete most of his work at home, using software to allow him to work remotely. He generally comes to the Temple on occasion to sign checks and deliver reports. This job does not require daily attendance at the Temple.

The Recorder's job is very important, as he is responsible for the filing of all necessary reports with Imperial, as well as for keeping all of the records of the Temple. He also is responsible for answering administrative questions of the Nobility. Generally, the Recorder should be in the office during the days it is open, which are now on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Both the Recorder and Treasurer are members of the Divan and are required to attend their meetings and to assist the Potentate in his duties.

We would encourage each of you to consider any men whom you feel would be good candidates for these positions and to communicate their names to either Illustrious Matt Clarke, Potentate or Noble Aubrey Rosser, Chief Rabban. Either would be willing to speak with you regarding any questions you might have.

We are pleased with the direction of our Temple this year, particularly in light of the 28 new members we took in at the May Ceremonial. Optimism is high for the up-coming activities, including the Circus and Gun Raffle. Our Units and Clubs are very active and the spirit of our Temple is good.

Incidentally, our Temple won a Gold Award from Imperial for the increase of our membership over the last year and will be recognized at our annual Shriner's International meeting in Minneapolis in July. We need to keep this going!

Shriners International Legacy Program

The Legacy Program celebrates our fraternal bonds with those closest to us. Shriners International invites nobles to be part of the Legacy Program and to encourage family members to participate.

Shriners International Legacy Month is celebrated in June, coinciding with Shriners International Awareness Day (June 6) and Father's Day. This special time unites nobles who make their fraternal membership a family tradition – welcoming grandfathers, fathers, sons, uncles and nephews, in-laws and others who have multiple Shriners within the same family. During this month, temples are encouraged to promote membership and honor the members who have taken part in this program.







Pass Along the Shriners Legacy

All family members who are Shriners are eligible to become part of the Legacy Program. To make the registration process easy, only one member of the family's legacy needs to register. Go to shrinersinternational.org. Click on Member Center, then scroll down and click on Membership. Scroll down to find the Legacy program link.

Each Legacy can download a certificate signed by the Imperial Potentate and Imperial Recorder. Shriners and their registered relatives can also order a special gold Legacy pin. Any new Shriners Legacy is eligible to receive a free pin for himself and up to two of his Shrine legacies. Nobles who became Shriners legacies prior to Jan. 1, 2012, are encouraged to become part of Shriners Legacy Program; these nobles may order a Legacy pin and certificate for themselves and their legacies for a contribution of \$5 or more per pin.



HANK WILLIAMS JR. - BOCEPHUS IS COMING BACK TO THE SALEM CIVIC CENTER!

FRIDAY, JULY 29, 2022 | 8:00 PM

One of the most iconic performers in country music history is returning to the Salem Civic Center in July of 2022. Hank Williams Jr., who first performed in Salem during the arena's first full year of operation in the spring of 1968, will return to the stage on Friday, July 29th.

With six RIAA-certified Platinum albums, 20 RIAA Gold-certified albums and over 70 million sold, Country Music Hall of Fame member Hank Williams Jr. announces a limited number of 2022 tour dates. As a touring artist, Hank was a pioneer in bringing arena rock production values to country music, and he remains one of the most consistent ticket sellers in music, period, as generation after generation gets turned on to one of the most dynamic live performers ever to take the stage.

"It's about that time, and you better believe I'm ready brothers and sisters," the icon shares. "We're bringing some blues, some rock and some country back to country."

One of the most influential artists of his time, Williams Jr. has helped define Country music in his five-decade career, earning titles as Entertainer of the Year from both the ACM and CMA, winning a GRAMMY Award along with his 10 nominations from The Recording Academy and receiving recognition as a songwriter as a BMI Icon and a member of the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame.

Kazim has the opportunity to sell CDs prior to this event and is looking for volunteers to help! If you are interested in helping, please contact Cole David at hpp@kazimshriners.com.

Currently there are no specific details for everything this entails, but as it was expressed to us anyone who helps to sell CDs will have free parking and a free ticket into the event. Times and locations will be given out once available.
