Much to the delight of everyone, the 2022 Kazim Sportsmans' Raffle was a huge success. Our Nobles did a wonderful job of selling over 6500 tickets, resulting in gross receipts of over \$130,000.00. Of that amount, 10% was donated to the Temple's Transportation fund, per gaming guidelines as in years past. After costs of approximately \$47,000.00, the Temple will benefit to the extent of approximately \$70,000. As most of us know, we can use these funds for our building, but not for our everyday use. With the projects going on now, these funds will be very useful.

Many thanks to Phillip's Equipment for assistance with the John Deere Gator, New London Trailers, Henry Rifles, and of course, Sportsman's Warehouse, for all of their generous assistance in this project. We also appreciate the Leaf and Cork Club for manning the bar, and for doing so without an ABC violation!

Of course, we also thank all who purchased tickets to support this project. Another great year for Kazim and our nobility!


#### Circus Update

I want to thank each Noble for all your assistance, support and presence for participating and being a part of this years Kazim Shrine Circus. We didn't have the overall attendance and financial outcome we had hoped for, but none the less a successful circus overall. I feel we did as much as we could have done and more to try and reach out and attract everyone to attend, but either there wasn't enough interest or other conflicting events that prevented us from having the attendance we had hoped for. I truly believe we made a lot of families many happy memories and a lot of happy kids really enjoyed themselves, but unfortunately for us that didn't provide us the money we needed.

On a more positive note, we were able to utilize the marketing capabilities of the Civic Center to capture and increase our market share dramatically by basically spending the same amount of money and receiving larger discounts than doing it ourselves. The savings resulted in over \$4000. We were able to expand into the Spanish community and in the School Systems throughout our Temple's footprint, enabling Kazim Shriners to be recognized and visible as part of our communities. The Trunk or Treat was a huge success, and I would recommend doing it again regularly as a community service and visibility, even if we don't do another circus.

## My FezCard Viewer

Have you downloaded the new My FezCard Viewer app? Get access to your digital membership card on your smartphone without the need to carry a physical card in your wallet.

# Download now on the **App Store** and **Google Play**.

For members who do not own a smartphone, the local Shrine Center, Club, or Unit can scan the QR code on their existing gold-colored membership hard card to instantly determine their membership status and check-in for stated meetings/events.

## Newly Designed Membership Card

Equally exciting is the launch of the newly designed membership card. Effective August 2022, members who pay their 2023 dues will have immediate access to their newly designed, Black digital membership card!

The design of the card had three needs requirements, it must be "classy" and "bold" while retaining Shrine DNA. To achieve this goal, inspiration was drawn from the membership and financial cards recognized by society as having influence and importance including VIP cards, luxury cards and black edition cards. The key to accomplishing "classy" was decluttering the information to ensure that only the most valuable text remained, which through the act of simplification raises the prominence of these areas. "Bold" was pursued in several areas including; reinforcing the Shrine Center and member name as the primary priority on the front, the selection/reinforcement of Shrine iconography in both the foreground and background on the front, and the increased prominence of the Shrine color by featuring a black background.


