Kazim Shrine Circus

The Kazim Shrine Circus has been tentatively scheduled for June 4th, 5th, and 6th. This will obviously depend on how the restrictions with Covid-19 are lifted over the year, but we will be anticipating these dates happening as of now.

You will notice that we have removed the Thursday night event. This is in an effort to help our Nobles as they were asked to do many shows in the past and spread themselves thin. Hopefully having less shows will help to alleviate some of the stress and pressure.





SDA

The Shrine Directors Association (SDA) of Shriners International is a organization of Director's Staffs from various temples. Each year the SDA holds a convention to promote Director's Staff activities, elect a Board of Directors and regional representatives (Board of Governors) and hold a stunt competition. Kazim Temple has been selected to host the SDA 2021 Convention. The convention will be held in Roanoke August 4th - 7th. This year marks the first time any temple in Virginia has hosted an SDA convention.





SASA Hotel Update

The 48th Annual Fall Festival for SASA is scheduled for September 16–19 in Myrtle Beach. Kazim Shrine Center will be staying at the Crown Reef Beach Resort and Waterpark.

The Crown Reef is located at 2918 South Ocean Blvd which is where the parade ends. They have blocked rooms for us with a discounted rate and a release date of August 14th. Assuming we do get to go to SASA that would mean there has been some relief on the Covid-19 front and it will most likely be a busy place. We strongly suggest that if you plan on attending SASA to make your reservations ASAP.

When calling for reservations indicate "Kazim Shriners" to get the discounted rate. They have several floor plans with different prices available to us. To make reservations call the office at 844-827-2434.

We realize that some Nobles may have already or will make reservations at other Hotels. If you wish to remain there that's okay. It just means you will need to travel to the Crown Reef to attend the Temple party or the Hospitality Rooms. If you desire to cancel and move to the Crown Reef and purchased the insurance plan that was offered you should be able to cancel with only the loss of the cost of the insurance.

House Committee Update

As opposed the usual report from your House Committee, we felt it might be good to let our Nobles know what the Committee has been doing at building.

- Repaired sidewalk and curb
- Repaired front steps
- Replaced handrail on front steps
- Replaced treads on stairs going downstairs
- Refinished ballroom floor
- Painted ballroom walls
- Replaced broken wall mirrors in ballroom
- Replaced exterior doors on 7the street side due to swelling and unable to open
- Added sidewalks and landing pads to both side doors
- Replaced all the faucets in the main floor Men's bathroom (still have three more to be installed in the lady's restroom)
- Replaced carpet in office, boardroom, and lady's restroom lounge.
- Updated landscaping in front of building, with the removal of several overgrown trees and shrubs to improve the visibility of the building and sign.
- Removed the old concrete loading dock in the rear of building to make it safer for children and others.
- Replaced roof on the picnic shelter. (Labor provided by volunteers, overseen by Mike Henderson)
- Remodeled Arab Room (removed old paneling, plastered, and painted walls)
- Remodeled Men's and Women's downstairs restrooms
- Remodeled downstairs breakroom
- Replaced ageing and failing phone system with new system
- Added Wi-Fi to entire building and network cable to key locations in the building, including ballroom.
- Added keyless entry to the building to replace aging keysets and locks

Replaced leaking hot water heater

- On-going project to replace all light fixtures with LEDS when possible. (LEDS installed thus far, ballroom, Arab room, boardroom, front porch, downstairs hallway, and back parking lot)
- Programable thermostats to help reduce utility costs
- Removed cable TV to unit rooms and replaced with over-the air antenna
- Currently in progress and awaiting final approval of City Permit- a new internal door
- which will allow access to another exit via the equipment room in the Northwest corner of downstairs.
- (Currently no exits on the West side of the building accessible to downstairs unit rooms)

New Items Added

 High intensity ceiling projector and 12-foot retractable projector in the ballroom

Donated Items

- Two programable spotlights (donated by Wes Wells)
- Commercial Sound system with wireless microphone (donated by Steve Nelson)
- Plus, numerous items from network switches to roofing cement, too many to count, that were donated selflessly to our fraternity.

Also, note that the kitchen was updated by the Roanoke Valley Shrine Club, which donated all the time and money to modernize our kitchen. While maybe not up to 21ist century standards, it is at least late 20th century. A separate report should probably be done on the kitchen.

The Fund which enabled us to do the work above, plus hundreds of smaller items too numerous to list was started by a donation from the estate of Illustrious Dr. Wallace Nunley. In addition, there have been on-going donations to the fund from various clubs, units, and individuals. Including the Friday night line dances hosted and donated by Noble Steve Nelson.

It should be noted that where possible volunteer labor was used to reduce cost to the temple. To all those that donated their time, energy, money, and in some case shed blood, the temple owes you a great THANK YOU. We hope that ALL can enjoy the fruits of a combined effort in 2021.




Meet your new Potentate
